Dear Viper families,

We hope this letter finds you safe and sound, as we know the latter part of the school year has been somewhat of an anomaly. Thank you students and families for your continued support during this unprecedented time. We acknowledge your efforts as we all adjusted to a new way of learning from home. While we know distance learning has been challenging for many families, we are proud of the resiliency and perseverance our students and their families have demonstrated. The following informational items are to inform you of our end of year processes.

Report Card Distribution: Term 2 report cards will be distributed to families next week on Thursday, June 25th or Friday, June 26th. Sibling report cards will be bundled together so that families will only have to make one trip to the school. If for some reason you are unable to pick up the report card(s), please contact Mrs. Debbie Novak to make alternative arrangements. Report cards that do not get picked up from the school after July 3rd, will be mailed out to families. We are requesting families pick up their child's/ren's reports on the following schedules:

- Kindergarten students: Thursday, June 25th, 9:30am-11:30am
- Primary students, Grades 1 and 2: Thursday, June 25th, 12:30pm-3:30pm
- Junior students, Grades 3, 4, and 5: Friday, June 26th, 9:30am-11:30am

Grade six students will pick up their report cards on Thursday, June 25th during their evening Grad Celebration drive through.

- Students with last names beginning with A-M: 5:00-6:00 pm
- Students with last names beginning with N-Z: 6:00-7:00 pm

Grade six students will get out of the car to drop off their chromebook, library book(s) or VV Vacation draw tickets in a designated area and then pick up their report card and grad package off of a table. Teachers and school administrators will be present to congratulate and cheer our grade six students from a safe distance. Feel free to honk your horn as your child picks up their grad package.

We ask that families drop off chromebooks, library books and vacation draw tickets at this time. If your child's school issued learning device requires repairs, please include a note and place in the "Needs Repairs" bin. We are asking families to drive into the main entrance of the parking lot. Staff will be present to direct the traffic flow. To ensure social distancing, only one member may leave the car. Teachers and school administrators will be present to send farewell wishes to students from a safe distance.
