Dear Viper families,

We hope this letter finds our families healthy, safe and enjoying spring! At this time, we would like to communicate to families the process for the retrieval of your child's/childrens personal items from Valleyview.

Currently, teachers are contacting families this week to determine who requires student belongings from the school. If you are choosing not to pick up personal items, staff will still gather all student belongings to be stored in the building so custodial staff can clean the school. At this time, we cannot guarantee another opportunity for families to pick up student's personal belongings. If for some reason you are unable to pick up during the scheduled time frame, please contact the school. We will do our best to make alternative arrangements for pick up.

To reduce the number of visits to the school, personal belongings will be released according to an alphabetized pick up schedule, organized by last name, during the week of June 8-12, 2020. Student items will be in a bag (clearly labelled with the students first and last name on it) located in alphabet groupings outside of the school that will be marked for easy reference. We will follow similar guidelines as our Vacation Draw ticket/money collection to ensure social distancing and safe handling practices are followed. We will not be able to permit you access to the building at any time. Further details regarding the pick up schedule will be shared with families in the near future.

If you have *library books* in your possession, there will be a designated blue box bin next to the east doors to drop off books. At this time, we are not collecting board issued learning devices and will organize another drop off schedule at the end of June, when learning from home is completed.
