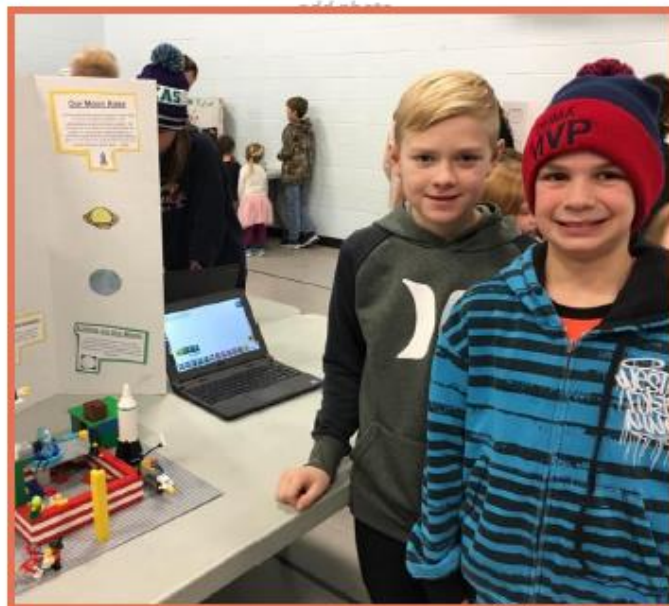


Valleyview Happenings December 2018
